

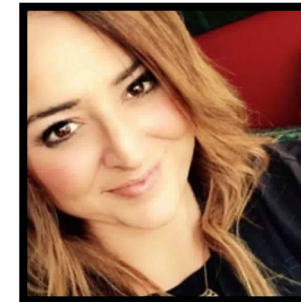

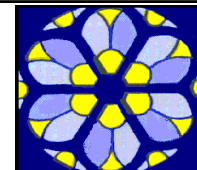

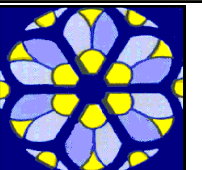
Get ready for November! Enjoy the falling leaves, Thanksgiving, and togetherness.

If we do not have enough interest for a group with volunteers there may not be a potluck.



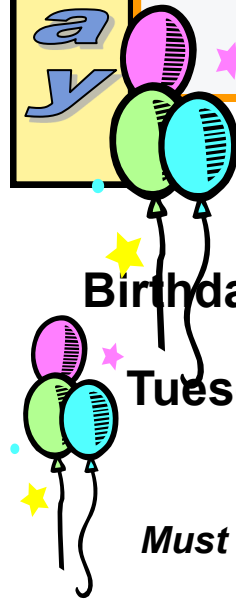

The games were wacky and fun. I cannot wait till Spring!

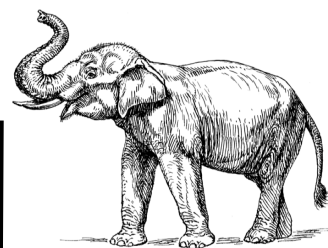
The Travelling Vietnam Memorial Wall will be at State Flag Plaza on Memorial Drive November 5th and 6th.
