





Lightning's behavior is random and unpredictable. We recommend a very conservative attitude towards it. Preparedness and quick responses are the best defenses towards the lightning hazard. - No diving.
- No skinny-dipping. No smoking. No pets allowed. No class containers : No horseplay.

12.	No glass containers permitted.
13.	No alcoholic beverages allowed at the pool before 5 pm weekdays and 2 pm on weekends, no exceptions.
14.	Due to the smell and attraction of insects especially wasps, residents consuming alcoholic beverages are asked to take all cans or
	plastic containers with them when they leave the pool area each time they visit.
15.	Unnecessary noise is not permitted at any time. Be courteous and thoughtful while using the pool and pool area.
16.	All residents and guest are responsible for picking up after themselves.

21.	Southpointe residents do not have pool privileges unless SouthPointe residents are guests of Westminster Village residents.
	Southpointe residents signed a document at move in acknowledging they do not have access to the swimming pool. The
	swimming pool is for 55 and older residents. Westminster Village residents must help us enforce our Southpointe restrictions.
	If we allow some Southpointe residents access, this will make an uncomfortable situation for the other Southpointe residents.

23.	Resident guests must be willing to give PRIORTY usage to WMV Residents.


